

The proprietor shall ensure the following:

- that a sufficient number of signs are conspicuously posted so as to clearly identify that smoking is prohibited;
- that no ashtrays are placed or allowed to remain visible in areas where smoking is prohibited pursuant to this bylaw;
- the proprietor shall advise any and all patrons violating this bylaw to refrain from smoking immediately;
- if a patron refuses to comply, the proprietor should call 786-1725 to contact bylaw enforcement;
- if they are unable to speak with a Bylaw Enforcement Officer then the following would apply;
 - After meeting all the above requirements, if a patron refuses to comply, the proprietor is to take down the patrons name and address (ask for ID) and pass this on to the Bylaw Enforcement Officers who will at that time send out a warning letter and/or ticket.
 - If the patron is causing a disturbance – the RCMP should be contacted in the same manner that you would call them for any type of disturbance;

This is provided to you for your information; however, it has been the experience in other cities that the Bylaw becomes self-enforcing.
