The Gallagher Centre, the major sports, convention and leisure activity centre owned and operated by the City of Yorkton, owns the exclusive rights in Saskatchewan and Manitoba to market and administer the White Lable Box Office Solutions ticketing system. The system is comparable to similar systems operated by national and international ticketing systems, but concentrates on providing systems to smaller venues that wish to have a greater level of control over their own ticketing. The system allows tickets to be sold online, by telephone, and in person.

The Gallagher Centre has successfully used the system since the fall of 2009, and is interested in expanding the use of the system by providing it to other venues in Saskatchewan, Manitoba and beyond. DETAILS OF PROPOSAL:
The City of Yorkton commissioned a review of its transportation network in 2003. That review updated a 1987 study and outlined traffic improvements required at the 25,000 population threshold. Yorkton continues to grow since the 2003 study was completed. With this growth has come new commercial and residential development not anticipated by the 2003 TMP as well as agri-industrial development outside of the City. It is important to ensure that the transportation network continues to meet the demands of the population as well as recent annexation applications. To that end, the City seeks to update the 2003 study.
