Bylaw No. 1/2013

A Bylaw in the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to provide for the permanent closure of Potoski Street as needed for re-alignment of the right-of-way

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following street be permanently closed:

“All that portion of Potoski Street shown on Registered Plan No. 95Y09225, as identified on Schedule ‘A’, attached to and forming part of this bylaw.”

Effective Date of Bylaw

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.

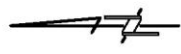

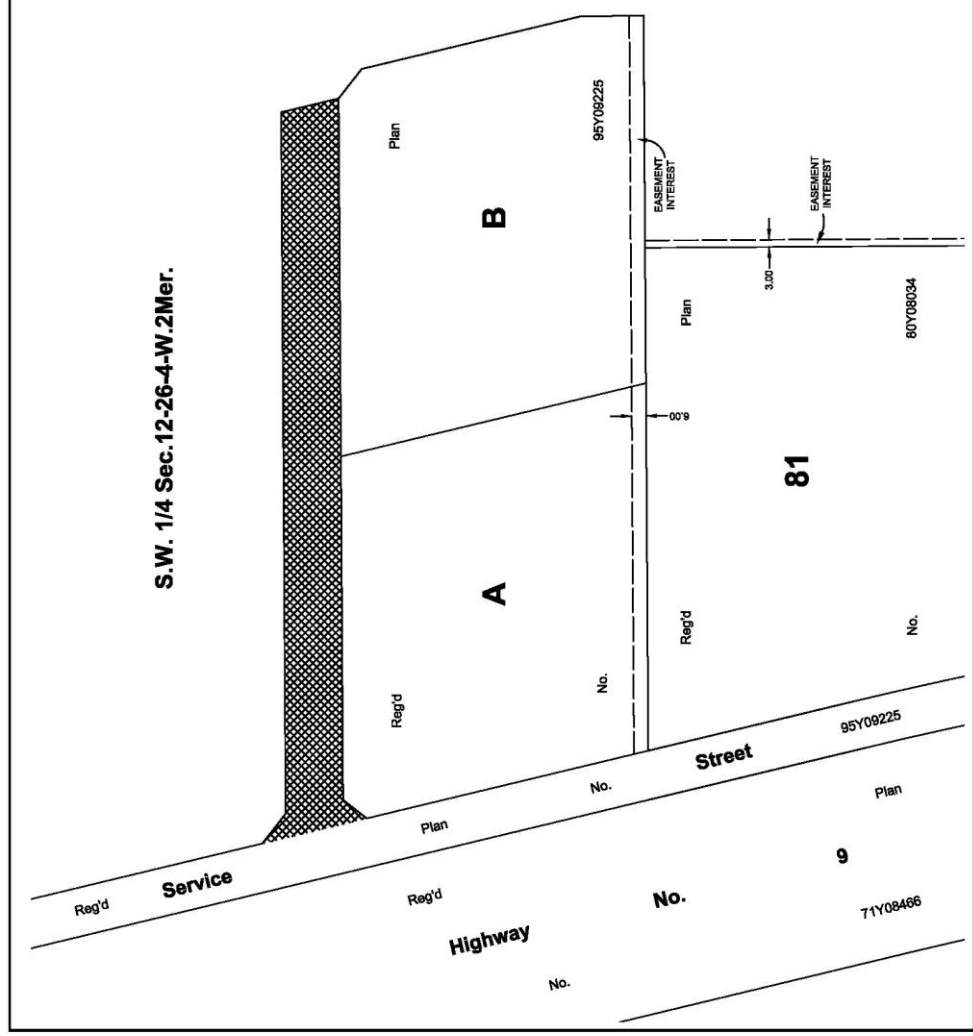
