Bylaw No. 1/2018

A Bylaw of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to Repeal Certain Bylaws

WHEREAS, as per Section 28(2)(b) of *The Cities Act*, the Council may authorize a revision bylaw omitting and providing for the repeal of a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective, and;

WHEREAS, Yorkton's Habitat for Humanity Restore ceased its operations on July 31, 2017 due to financial unsustainability, and therefore is deemed inoperative;

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton enacts as follows:

1. That the following Bylaws be repealed:

Bylaw No. 10/2014 – A Bylaw to Lend Money to the Regina Habitat for Humanity Restore on Behalf of the Yorkton Habitat for Humanity Restore

Bylaw No. 13/2017 – Repeal Bylaw
