**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO REPLACE BYLAW 19/95
AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PUBLIC RESERVE LAND**

WHEREAS, the City of Yorkton desires to sell Municipal Reserve MR3.

AND WHEREAS, Bylaw No. 19/95 approved by the Minister was rejected by the Yorkton Land Titles Office requiring an exception and minerals clause.

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That pursuant to Section 200(2) of The Planning and Development Act, 1983, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to request and execute such documents as may be necessary by the Minister of Municipal Government to sell the following dedicated land:

Municipal Reserve MR3
Yorkton, Saskatchewan
Plan No. 61Y05009
Except: Portion on Plan 92Y05485
MINERALS IN THE CROWN

2. Bylaw No. 19/95, passed June 12, 1995 and approved June 29, 1995 by the Deputy Minister of Municipal Government, is hereby repealed.
3. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Municipal Government.
