BYLAW NO. 10/2016

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
TO ESTABLISH THE REQUIREMENT OF A CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK IN
ADDITION TO THE NOMINATION PAPERS TO BE SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO
SECTION 67 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTION ACT, 2015**

WHEREAS, Section 63.1 of *The Cities Act*, provides that Council may, by bylaw, require that every candidate submit a criminal record check in the form required in addition to the nomination paper submitted pursuant to Section 67 of *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*;

AND WHEREAS, Section 67 (6) OF *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*, includes that ‘No nomination is complete or shall be accepted by the returning officer unless the nominee’s acceptance of nomination statement is accompanied by any criminal record check required pursuant to a bylaw passed pursuant to *The Cities Act*’;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Yorkton desire to establish the requirement of a criminal record check to be attached to the Nomination Papers to be submitted;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. Every candidate seeking election for municipal office shall obtain a criminal record check in the required Form A.2, shown as Attachment 1 hereto, and
 - (a) shall have attached to Form A.2, the criminal record check received from the candidate’s local police service; and
 - (b) the Criminal Record check must have been completed by the local police service not more than 30 days before the date that the Nomination papers are submitted to the Returning Officer.
2. Every candidate shall be responsible for all costs associated with obtaining the criminal record check.
3. The criminal record check shall be included with and form part of the nomination form submitted by the candidate for municipal office.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof.
