BYLAW NO. 11/2009

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF ONE LANEWAY**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following laneway be closed:

“All that portion of the lane shown on Plan 00Y10405 lying in Block 1 between the Southerly production of the West limit of Lot 13, Block and the Westerly production of the South limit of Lot 19, Block 1, Yorkton, Saskatchewan.”

More specifically as shown in the shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A' which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

Effective Date of Bylaw

Consent to close this lane was given by the Minister of Highways on June 20, 2008. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.
