**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSING OF A CERTAIN ROAD AS
SUCH ROAD IS SHOWN ON A PLAN OF RECORD IN THE LAND TITLES OFFICE
AS NO. CE3845**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 156 of *The Urban Municipality Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled hereby enacts that following road be closed:

“All that portion of Fourth Avenue South lying South of a line joining the most Northerly North East corner of Lot 1, Block 29 and the most Northerly North West corner of Lot 1, Block 30 on Plan No. CE3845.”
