Bylaw No. 15/2018

A Bylaw of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to amend Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 12/2014 by changing the Land Use Concept for 60 Fifth Avenue North from Institutional to Commercial

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 29(2) and 39 of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 12/2014 is amended to change the Land Use Concept for Lot 35, Block 9, Plan 00Y05677, civically known as 60 Fifth Avenue North, as shown on Schedule 'A' attached hereto, from Institutional to Commercial.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect from the date on which it is approved by the Minister of Government Relations.
