BYLAW NO. 1525

A BYLAW to provide for changing the name of a certain street.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to change the name of Parker Avenue to Dalebrooke Drive; and

WHEREAS authority to make such a change is provided by Section 235, Subsection 1, Chapter 137, Paragraph 105, Revised Statutes of Saskatchewan, 1953.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton does hereby resolve that the street now named Parker Avenue, as the said Parker Avenue is shown on Plan 60YO6981, and on Plan AA5778, as both plans are registered in the Yorkton Land Titles Office, be and hereby is named Dalebrooke Drive.
