BYLAW NO. 1551

**A BYLAW for controlling, preventing use of, and removal of, outside privies and privy vaults
within the city limits.**

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the orderly and hygienic development of the City to eliminate the use of outside privies, outside privy vaults, within the limits of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled, doth hereby enact as follows:

1. The Council may from time to time as it deems expedient, by resolution, require the owners and occupiers of property within any defined area within the City, to remove and cease to use any outside privy or privy vaults situate on said property.
2. The owner of property referred to in Clause 1 hereof shall, within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of notice, requiring him so to do, mailed to him by registered mail, addressed to his address, as shown in the last revised Assessment Roll of the City, remove, demolish, and cease to use, any outside privy or privy vaults on the premises set forth in said Notice, and shall cause the said privy vault to be filled with earth to ground level.
3. If the owner or occupier of said premises fails or neglects to comply with the said Notice, within the time therein limited, the City may do the work required and charge the expense thereof against the property set forth in said Notice, and said charge shall be added to the taxes assessed against said property and be collectible as such.

4. If land is occupied by any other than the assessed owner, and the occupant fails or neglects to discontinue the use of any outside privy or privy vault, or fails to fill in the said outside privy or privy vault with earth as required herein, he shall be guilty of an offence and punishable therefor under the City's General Penalty Bylaw.

5. The provisions of this Bylaw shall apply only to property owned or occupied, a portion of which land adjoins a street or lane along which a domestic sewer main has been laid adjacent to such property.
