Bylaw No. 16/2015

**A Bylaw of the City of Yorkton in the Province of
Saskatchewan to Provide for a Recycling Service Fee**

WHEREAS, Section 8(1)(i) of *The Cities Act* provides for set fees in connection with any services provided by the City;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Yorkton deems it expedient to impose a fee for a recycling service;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. That there shall be added to the utility bill for each residential unit, a recycling fee of \$6.00 per month.
2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2016.
3. Repealed Bylaw

Bylaw No. 1/2010 passed on the 11th day of January, 2010, establishing a recycling service fee of \$5.00 per month is hereby repealed.
