**BYLAW NO. 17/87**

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO ESTABLISH  
A YORKTON AND DISTRICT MUTUAL AID AREA AND  
TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO A MUTUAL AID  
AGREEMENT**

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The Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Council of the City of Yorkton to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement hereto attached and identified as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw to establish a Yorkton & District Mutual Aid Area for the purpose of providing mutual assistance to the parties so named in the event of any declared disaster or emergency under the provisions of the said agreement.
2. The Mayor and City Commissioner are hereby authorized and directed to execute the said agreement on behalf of the City of Yorkton and to affix the seal of the municipality thereto.
3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.

Introduced and read a first time this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, A.D., 1987.

Read a second time this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, A.D., 1987.

Read a third time this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, A.D., 1987 after unanimous agreement had been reached to have a third reading, passed this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March, A.D., 1987, and registered in the Bylaw Register of the City of Yorkton.

- (1) The above named parties to the Agreement form, the Yorkton and District Mutual Aid Area.
- (2) Each of the named parties to the Agreement willingly commit their assistance to the other parties in the event of any declared disaster, or emergency requiring specialized equipment.
- (3) Each party has agreed to recognize the City of Yorkton as the Emergency Measures Organization Control Centre.
- (4) All parties to this Mutual Aid Agreement have unanimously agreed that the objective of our organization shall be:
  - (a) to jointly plan and provide an effective organization for the purpose of lending assistance in the form of manpower, equipment and expertise to the declared area of disaster;
  - (b) to meet regularly for the purposes of updating policies and procedures;
  - (c) maintain a communication system within the mutual aid district;
  - (d) prepare, maintain and exchange resource manuals;
  - (e) jointly ascertain the requirements of the mutual aid area and submit requests and proposals to the appropriate agencies;
  - (f) prepare and institute a public awareness program;

Without limiting the parties of this Mutual Aid Area to expand and improve their local organizations the following projects shall be considered priority:

- I. The implementation of a complete integrated communication system.
- II. The training of individuals from each centre or R.M. in proper emergency preparedness procedures by attending recognized training facilities.
- III. To complete the construction of the mobile command unit presently housed in the City of Yorkton.

IV. To institute and maintain public education and information programs.

It is understood that any of the existing communities that may wish to dissolve their partnership in this Mutual Aid Agreement may do so by providing written notification of their termination sixty (60) days prior to the effective date.

It is further understood that any equipment purchased by and housed in the community wishing to withdraw from the Mutual Aid Agreement shall remain in that community for their use and deployment at the discretion of their governing authority.

It shall be the responsibility of the control committee of this Mutual Aid area to determine if the area can or should expand in the event of requests from additional communities.
