BYLAW NO 18/2000

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSING OF A CERTAIN STREET AS
SUCH STREET IS SHOWN ON A PLAN OF RECORD IN THE LAND TITLES OFFICE
AS NO. 90Y05020**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 156 of *The Urban Municipality Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following street be closed:

“FIRSTLY: All that portion of Dracup Avenue, Yorkton, Saskatchewan, Plan 90Y05020 lying South of a line joining the most North Easterly corner of Lot 1, Block 77, with the most North Westerly corner of lot 1, block 76 on said Plan.

SECONDLY: All that portion of Dracup Avenue, Yorkton, Saskatchewan, being Original Road Allowance, East and adjacent to the North East Quarter of Section 35, Township 25, Range 4, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, and described as lying South of the South limit of Lot 1, Block 76, Plan 90Y05020 and North of the North Easterly limit of Railway Right of Way on Plan 39669.”

More specifically as shown in bold outline on the map, identified as Schedule ‘A’ which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.
