BYLAW NO. 2/92

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSING OF
CERTAIN LANES AS SUCH LANES ARE SHOWN ON A PLAN OF RECORD IN THE
LAND TITLES OFFICE AS PLAN NO. 7023.**

In Accordance with Section 156 of the Urban Municipalities Act, the Council of the City of Yorkton enacts that the following lanes be closed:

Firstly: the most South Easterly 25 feet in perpendicular width throughout of Lot 44

Secondly: All that portion of the East West lane lying to the South East of a line drawn parallel with and perpendicularly 25 feet North Westerly from the South Easterly limit of Lot 44.
