BYLAW NO. 2008

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO CLARIFY THE MEANING
OF THE TERM "EX OFFICIO".**

WHEREAS a number of bylaws of the City of Yorkton appoint members to Committees using the term “ex officio”; and

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to clarify the meaning of use of such term.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. THAT wherever the term "ex officio" is used in the appointment of any person to a Committee, it is deemed to mean that he is appointed by virtue of his office, and further, that he has the same rights as to participation for the purpose of discussion and/or voting on any question or decision in which such Committee may be involved.

Introduced and read a first time this 29th day of March A. D. 1977.

Read a second time this 11th day of April A. D. 1977.

Read a third time this 11th day of April A. D. 1977, and passed unanimously and registered in the Bylaw Register Of the City of Yorkton.
