BYLAW NO. 23/97

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE THAT BUSINESSES NOT BE ASSESSED**

WHEREAS Section 240 of The Urban Municipality Act provides authority to City Council with respect to business assessment and;

WHEREAS Section 240(3) of The Urban Municipality Act provides Council with authority to pass a bylaw to provide that businesses will not be assessed within the urban municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. That under the authority of Section 240(3) of The Urban Municipality Act, businesses will not be assessed within the City of Yorkton.
2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on final passing thereof.
3. Bylaw No. 47/96 passed on the 6th day of January, 1997 providing that businesses not be assessed for the year 1997 is hereby repealed.
