**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSING OF CERTAIN STREETS
AS SUCH STREETS ARE SHOWN ON A PLAN OF RECORD IN THE LAND
TITLES OFFICE AS NOS. A02901 AND 7023.**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 156 of *The Urban Municipality Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled hereby enacts that following streets be closed:

- “- All of the lane in Block 4, Plan A02901
- All of the north-south lane in Block 8, Plan 7023
- All that portion of the east-west lane lying easterly of a line joining the northwest corner of Lot 34, Block 8 to the southwest corner of Lot 22, Block 8, Plan 7023.”
