**BYLAW NO. 25/89**

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO DESIGNATE  
CERTAIN PROPERTY AS MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY**

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The Council of the City of Yorkton in accordance with the Heritage Property act enacts as follows:

1. That the property described as follows be designated as Municipal Heritage Property,

Legal - Lot 5,  
Block 1,  
Plan 9913  
Yorkton, Saskatchewan  
(Minerals excepted)

Civic Description - 19 Broadway Street East,  
Yorkton, Saskatchewan.

Registered owner: Sampson Furniture Ltd.

2. The reasons for the designation are as follows:
  - a) Purchased in 1898 from a pioneer storekeeper to become the Hudson's Bay Company post in Yorkton.
  - b) Rebuilt in 1913 and modelled after Hudson's Bay Company structure of major cities in Canada.
  - c) The architectural design is unique to Yorkton and a focal point on Broadway Street.
  - d) It is one of two such buildings in Saskatchewan.
  - e) The European style terra-cotta sculpture is the major exterior decoration.

Introduced and read a first time this 23 day of October A.D., 1989.

Read a second time this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D., 1990.

Read a third time this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D., 1990, after unanimous agreement had been reached to have a third reading, and then passed unanimously this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D., 1990, and registered in the Bylaw Register of the City of Yorkton.
