**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO AUTHORIZE THE DEREGISTRATION AND SALE OF
PUBLIC RESERVE LAND**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Pursuant to Section 200(2) of *The Planning and Development Act, 1983*, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to request and execute such documents as may be necessary by the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Culture and Housing to sell a portion of Municipal Reserve lands as identified in Schedule "A", attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, for the development of two schools and a community centre at fair market value:

Public Reserve PR6;
Yorkton, Saskatchewan
Plan 87Y08562

ALL MINES AND MINERALS EXCEPTED BY 61Y10177, 76Y07477
and 87Y08562

with the sale proceeds to be allocated to the City of Yorkton's dedicated lands account.

2. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Culture and Housing.
