BYLAW NO. 31/2013

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR RESIDENTIAL REFUSE
COLLECTION AND REMOVAL IN THE CITY OF YORKTON.**

WHEREAS Section 8 of *The Cities Act* includes authorization for Council to establish fees for services provided by or on behalf of the City,

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Yorkton deems it appropriate to charge a fee for the collection and disposal of residential refuse.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. The following rate shall be charged for the collection and removal of residential refuse and shall be billed with the bimonthly utility billings as follows:

Residential – includes homes and buildings with up to and including 4 self-contained residential dwelling units.

\$10.65 per month for each residential unit

Multi-Family – includes buildings with greater than 4 self-contained dwelling units.

\$8.50 per month for each residential unit

2. The definition of refuse shall be that as defined in the “Solid Waste Bylaw No. 16-1981” or any amendments hereto.
3. Bylaw No. 38/2012 passed on the 3rd day of December, 2012 is hereby repealed.
4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2014.
