BYLAW NO. 32-1981

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO AMEND
BYLAW NO. 16-1981 PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL
OF GARBAGE, ASHES AND OTHER REFUSE.**

The Municipal Council of the City of Yorkton, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT Section 20(9) shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

"(9) No person shall burn any refuse or cause any fire to be set at the Sanitary Landfill Grounds, except in a designated dry disposal area; and no person shall deposit any combustible or inflammable refuse in the cell area of the said Sanitary Landfill Grounds except as directed."

2. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on the date that approval is received from the Minister of Public Health and the Minister of the Environment.

Introduced and read a first time this 30th day of November, A. D. 1981.

Read a second time this 30th day of November, A.D. 1981.

Read a third time this 30th day of November, A.D. 1981, after unanimous agreement had been reached to have a third reading and passed unanimously this 30th day of November, A. D. 1981, and registered in the Bylaw Register of the City of Yorkton.
