BYLAW NO. 33/98

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 9/97 TO ADMINISTER AND
REGULATE THE BILLBOARD SIGNS LOCATED WITHIN DESIGNATED
SIGNING CORRIDORS ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF YORKTON**

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable for the Council of the City of Yorkton to amend Bylaw No. 9/97;

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

That Bylaw No. 9/97 be amended as follows:

1. Section 4. BILLBOARD SIGN REGULATIONS STANDARDS
Section 4.1.3, Spatial Orientation

That b) be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“Billboard signs shall be placed a lateral distance of 63.3 metres (208 feet) from the centre line of a highway.”

2. That Schedule “A”, Designated Signing Corridor, be replaced with the attached map, adding corridors 2, 3 and 4 as approved by Saskatchewan Highways and Transportation, hereinafter called Schedule “A” and forming part of Bylaw No. 9/97.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval by the Minister of Highways and Transportation.
