**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND BYLAW 9/97 TO ADMINISTER AND
REGULATE BILLBOARD SIGNS LOCATED WITHIN DESIGNATED
SIGNING CORRIDORS ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF YORKTON**

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable for the Council of the City of Yorkton to amend Bylaw 9/97;

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

That Bylaw 9/97 be amended as follows:

- 1) That Schedule "A" Designated Signing Corridor as amended by Bylaw No. 33/98 be replaced with attached map adding corridor 5 as approved by Saskatchewan Highways and Transportation, hereinafter called Schedule "A" and forming part of Bylaw 9/97.
- 2) This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval by the Minister of Highways and Transportation.
