BYLAW NO. 39/2009

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF STREETS AND LANEWAYS
IN PHASE II OF THE “RIVERSIDE MEADOWS” SUBDIVISION**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following streets and laneways be closed:

Firstly: “All that portion of Good Spirit Crescent and Whitesand Drive and all of Grouse Bay, Partridge Court and Pheasant Cove and lanes in Blocks 4 & 5 lying North of the Northerly limit of Madge Way and it’s production Westerly across Good Spirit Crescent and West of the Westerly limit of Riverside Drive.”

Secondly: “All that portion of Riverside Drive lying to the North of a line drawn from the most Southerly point of the street cut-off at the Southeasterly corner of Lot 9, Block 5, to the most southerly point of street cut-off at the Southwesterly corner of Municipal Reserve, MR4.”

Thirdly: “All that portion of lane in Block 1, lying North of the Westerly production of Lot 26, Block 1.”

All said lots, Blocks, Streets, Drives and Lanes described above are shown on Registered Plan No. 00Y10405, Yorkton, Saskatchewan.

More specifically as shown in the cross-hatched area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A' which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

Effective Date of Bylaw

Consent to close these streets and laneways was given by the Minister of Highways on March 5, 2009. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.
