Bylaw No. 4/2012

A Bylaw of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to amend Bylaw No. 29/2002, a bylaw to Regulate and Control the Conduct of Passengers using Public Transit Vehicles, Station and Facilities in the City of Yorkton

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable for the Council of the City of Yorkton to amend Bylaw No. 29/2002 known as the Transit Bylaw.

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton enacts as follows:

1. PREAMBLE – That the wording be amended as follows:

“WHEREAS, the City of Yorkton *owns and operates* a public transportation system...”

TO:

“WHEREAS, the City of Yorkton *is responsible for a public transportation system...*”

2. FARES – That the wording be amended as follows:

Section 2.3 - “The fares for transit service are as *stated in Schedule “B” attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw*”

TO:

Section 2.3 - “The fares for transit service are as *agreed to under the terms of the Transit Services Contract dated October 1, 2011.*”

3. SCHEDULE “B” – Transit Fares – That Schedule “B” be deleted in its entirety.

4. Repealing Bylaw

That Bylaw No. 45/2010 passed on the 13th day of December 2010 is hereby repealed.

5. Effective Date of Bylaw

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passage.
