Bylaw No. 4/2013

**A Bylaw of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to
amend Bylaw No. 5/2011 being a Bylaw
Providing for the Appointment of a Planning and Infrastructure Commission**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Yorkton established the Municipal Heritage Advisory Sub-committee under the Planning & Infrastructure Commission as per Section 55 of *The Cities Act*.

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

THAT Bylaw No. 5/2011 is amended as follows:

1. That clause 3.1 be amended to read as follows with the changes in bold:

3.1 That a Planning and Infrastructure Commission of the City of Yorkton be established consisting of not more than **11** members and not less than 7 members who shall be appointed from time to time by resolution of Council and specified as follows:

- 2 members of Council
- 1 member of **Good Spirit School Division No. 204**
- 1 member of **Christ the Teacher Roman Catholic Separate School Division No. 212**
- **7 members** from the Community at Large
- City Council may appoint a municipal employee to the Commission provided that:
 - The employee has special relevant expertise to contribute; and/or
 - The appointment is necessary by virtue of the employee's office, and
 - There will be detrimental effect on the employee's normal responsibilities.

2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
