**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF HIGHWAY 9
NORTH AND BROADWAY STREET EAST WITHIN PLAN NO. 71Y08466**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following portions of streets be closed:

That 12.32 metre wide portion of Highway 9 North within Plan No. 71Y08466, and that 15.13 metre wide portion of Broadway Street East within Plan No. 71Y08466, as detailed in the hatched area on Schedule ‘A’, which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.
