BYLAW NO. 48/2008

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF ONE LANE**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8(1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following laneways be closed:

All that portion of lane in Block 12, Registered Plan 27474, Yorkton, Saskatchewan lying east of the easterly limit of First Avenue and west of the westerly limit of Second Avenue and south of a line joining the north easterly corner of Lot 44 to the north westerly corner of Lot 7, in said Block as shown on said registered plan.

More specifically, as shown in the cross-hatched areas on the map, identified as Schedule 'A', which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

Effective Date of Bylaw

The Minister of Highways and Infrastructure granted consent to the closing of this lane on Oct 9, 2008. As the Minister has already consented, this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passage thereof.
