**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 7/2011 BEING A BYLAW PROVIDING FOR THE
APPOINTMENT OF AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE.**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Yorkton establishes and defines the function of Committees deemed to be in the general interest of the community.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Yorkton wishes to acknowledge the increased interest in membership on the Economic Development Committee by amending the number of members from the City at large allowed on the Committee.

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

THAT Bylaw No. 7/2011 is amended by the following:

1. That clause 3.2.1 be re-worded to read:
3.2.1 Up to two members from the Council of the City of Yorkton.
2. That clause 3.2.2 be re-worded to add one more member from the City at large:
3.2.2 Up to nine members from the City at large.
3. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect immediately.
