**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO REGULATE  
THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS AND TO PROVIDE FOR FIRE  
PROTECTION AND HEALTH AND SANITATION REGULATIONS IN  
CONNECTION THEREWITH**

**WHEREAS** the National Research Council of Canada has compiled a National Building Code covering matters of construction of buildings and safeguarding of such against fire damage, and also including in said Code regulations in respect to the preservation of health and sanitation in construction; and

**WHEREAS** the said Code is deemed suitable for adoption by the City of Yorkton.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the said National Building Code as recommended and published by the National Research council of Canada shall be accepted in whole as a building bylaw of the City of Yorkton, governing all classes of construction, precautions against fire, and measures for preservation of health and sanitation, as set forth in detail in the said National Building code, and more particularly described as NRCC No. 30619, issued in the year 1990.
2. **THAT** Bylaw No. 19/86 of the City of Yorkton is hereby repealed.
