**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO AMEND THE
YORKTON PLANNING DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT PLAN BYLAW NO. 13/94**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Yorkton wishes to amend the Yorkton Planning District Development Plan Bylaw No. 13/94;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Yorkton is proceeding to amend the said bylaw in accordance with Section 207 of *The Planning and Development Act*;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Section 6.0 – Residential Land Use Objectives and Policies

That Section 6.4 – Single Parcel Country Residential Subdivisions, A. Policies, be amended by removing the following:

"3. a) 1 kilometre (0.6 mile) from York Lake or the Rousay Lakes."

2. Effective Date of Bylaw

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect after such time as the Minister of Government Relations and Aboriginal Affairs grants approval of the bylaw.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof.
