BYLAW NO. 8/95

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO PROVIDE FOR
THE OPENING OF CERTAIN STREETS AVENUES AND LANES AS SUCH
STREETS AVENUES AND LANES ARE SHOWN ON THE PLAN OF
RECORD IN THE LAND TITLES OFFICE AS NO. Z2528**

WHEREAS, Saskatchewan Property Registration Branch is requesting that the following streets, avenues and lanes remain open;

AND WHEREAS Bylaw No. 33/94 inadvertently closed certain streets, avenues and lanes still required for use by the public;

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled enacts that the following streets, avenues and lanes in Plan Z2528 and amended by Master of Titles Order No. CE3844 described as follows be opened:

Firstly: all that portion of Tupper Avenue lying to the North of the production Westerly of the most Westerly North limit of Parcel B Plan CE3845;

Secondly: all that portion of Second Avenue lying to the North of the Northerly limit of the former Edward Street;

Thirdly: all that portion of the Lane in Block 26 lying to the North of the production Easterly of the Southerly limit of Lot 11 in Block 26;

Fourthly: all that portion of the streets lying to the East of the Westerly limit of Roadway on Plan 62YO5821;

Fifthly: all of the avenues and lanes lying to the South of the Northerly limit of Roadway on Plan 76YO2353.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.

Read a first time this 27th day of February A.D. 1995.

Read a second time this 13th day of March A.D. 1995.

Read a third time and adopted this 13th day of March A.D. 1995.
