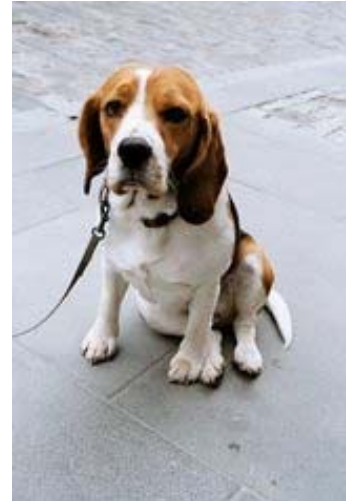


## Updated Animal Control Bylaw Highlights:

The Animal Control Bylaw was approved by Council on April 2nd, and now includes several new features to enhance the safety of children and the general public:

- All dogs must be leashed when off the property of the owner
- Dogs must be kept off playgrounds and sports fields such as ball diamonds and soccer pitches
- If your dog defecates on City property or private property other than your own, droppings must be cleaned up immediately. Dog droppings on your own property must be cleaned up and disposed of daily.
- All dogs must be licensed. Your contact information on the license is the most efficient way to have a lost dog returned to you. Licenses are available at City Hall, the local SPCA and local vet clinics.
