### Dutch Elm Pruning Ban is in effect from April 1st to September 1st

Dutch elm disease is a fungal disease that is spread by the elm bark beetle. The disease can also be spread by contaminated pruning equipment. Infected trees must be removed and discarded properly. Thanks to our Urban

Forestry Program and your support, the disease has been kept under control in Yorkton. We currently have 1,595 elm trees throughout the City.

For Birds During 4 **Peak Migration** 

March - May & August - October 11 pm - 6 am


Two thirds of all songbirds migrate at night. Light pollution can cause them to become confused. If possible, turn off all unnecessary lights. If this is not an option, use warm white or yellow coloured light bulbs, shield your light bulbs to direct light down and install motion sensors. If working indoors at night, close the drapes.
