Healthy Community

Promote and build a healthy community encouraging healthy lifestyles, personal wellness with quality health care.

- Facilitate the establishment of Health Clinics through collaboration
- Achieve improved retention of medical professionals through collaboration and partnerships with community stakeholders.
- Place public health as a priority in land use planning with goals and objectives that are explicitly about health, active living and address the multiple impacts of the built environment.
- Seek partnerships that promote health, wellness and healthy lifestyles.
- The City is known as a safe caring community with high standards of public safety and low crime rates.
- Provide a safe community by maintaining public safety and security through a focus on strategic prevention activities and timely emergency services.
- Collaborate with the Sunrise health Region for the development of a New Regional Health Care Facility

<u>Infrastructure</u>

A community with a comprehensive, integrated and sustainable infrastructure plan and programs that meet current and future needs.

- Develop a long term infrastructure plan that includes Water, Sewer, Roads, Sidewalks, walking trails, bike paths, Facilities, Transit and future development.
- Complete a Housing Study to determine complete needs for seniors/students/low income/First nations/Home ownership/rentals and establish priorities.
- Complete a Recreation/Culture needs assessment including facilities, capacities and utilization rates.
- Prepare a Parks and recreation master plan.
- Conduct a needs analysis, review the current transit system and develop a long-range transit plan.

Economic Development

A City that is open for business, providing an economic environment that embraces innovation and growth.

- Support and facilitate desired commercial and light industrial development consistent with Council policy and the Official Community Plan.
- In consultation with Economic Development Committee and key stakeholders develop and implement an economic development strategy.
- Improve relationships with Rural Municipalities to facilitate expanding available land for development. (RD4)
- Enhance tax policies to encourage upgrades to building and lots in disrepair.
- Create an economic environment that welcomes innovation and growth (new business, business retention, thriving business community technology).
- Develop an Economic Center at City Hall in partnership with Chamber of Commerce, YBID and SEER –"One Stop Shopping"

Community Development

Foster a safe community that embraces cultural and social diversity by providing social, recreational and educational opportunities for all community members.

- Improve quality of life opportunities, arts, culture, leisure.
- Community engagement provides opportunity for all members of the community to be involved and supported (disabled, seniors, immigrants, First Nations, and youth) Collective responsibility to promote city (pride).
- Establish a vibrant culture that celebrates diversity, arts, customs, food, fashions, museums, motion picture/film festival, heritage.
- Develop and maintain facilities that offer a diverse range of sports and recreational opportunities for youth to seniors including, spray parks, playgrounds, bike trails, walking paths and organized sports
- 2011 Gather groups of common interest to discuss and clarify each one's role in achieving the goal query what would make it work.
- Establish and use existing needs assessments to identify neighborhood needs, age related needs and priorities.
- Engage and empower groups in the execution of the plan.
- Have "Living" Plans for Arts Culture and Leisure.

Environment

A community that promotes environmental awareness, rethinks, recycles, reuses and uses green space and energy efficiently.

- Promote environmental responsibility, sustainability and stewardship (e.g. recycling, water and energy conservation, etc.) locally, including collaborating and participating in local, regional and/or provincial initiatives that support environmental protection.
- Use technology to increase efficiencies, reduce costs and reduce impact on environment (e.g. energy efficient buildings, paperless transactions, etc.).
- Continue to establish and promote bylaws, policies, regulations & practices that require and/or encourage the community to follow conservation methods (e.g. rate reviews, rebates, user-pay, etc.).
- Provide public education in water and energy conservation and promote reduction of household and business waste and increase in recycling.
- Encourage commercial, industrial and institutional businesses to increase conservation efforts to adopt environmentally responsible practices in all areas of the City operations.
- Create a corporate environmental stewardship plan.

Technology

Position technology as a means for community communication, create operational efficiencies, promote and facilitate economic activity.

- Invest in and implement technological change necessary to permit the public to conduct business with the city using the internet and other electronic media.
- Improve and maintain the City website with current and historical information.
- Implement and use new technology to provide efficiencies and information that leads to better long term planning and decision making.
- Deliver a community information and referral service that is fully automated.
- Conduct a review of social media tools to determine how such tools can be used to provide additional opportunities for citizen interaction and identity opportunities utilize social media sites to boost engagement.

Education

Foster strategic partnerships, to offer responsive, quality education for all citizens.

- Provide and/or facilitate delivery of life-long learning and skill development opportunities for children, youth, adults and seniors, encouraging a healthy lifestyle and active mind.
- Assist community groups in the delivery of life-long learning and skill development opportunities.
- Manage and deliver youth-oriented programming. Maintain and increase facilities: Parkland College, Public Library.
- Work with and support Parkland College in establishing a Trades and Technology Centre with a potential for future growth in the City.

Governance & Communication

The governance model is accountable, transparent, engages residents participation and involvement in policy development and goal setting.

- Provide opportunities for residents to participate in governance through policy, planning and strategic goal setting input.
- Provide targeted communication initiatives that inform residents of the community's vision, goals, strategies, plans and progress (e.g. annual business plan progress report, financial information, etc.) and/or to help them understand our decisions and services (e.g. community guides, etc.)
- Maintain and enhance inter-municipal relations as partners in providing services to our collective customers.
- Pursue open, timely and pertinent public communication of Council decisions, direction, community programs and municipal services.
- Provide priority information to residents and others in a variety of means to inform, engage
 and encourage residents to participate in good governance, policy development and to adopt
 actions that support sustainable community lifestyle choices.
- Provide meaningful opportunities for citizens to volunteer in our community that provide: opportunities for input and feedback, to gain work and life experience, as well as for Commission, Committee recruitment & retention and to promote social responsibility
 - Review volunteer recruitment & recognition practices
 - Survey citizen members of Council's Committees & Commissions to determine satisfaction and to improve recruitment & retention.
