

### **Why Some Sidewalks Are Cleared And Others Are Not**

- Trucking all the snow from sidewalks and streets would be cost prohibitive. Given most sidewalks are adjacent to the streets, snow is pushed up onto the sidewalks for storage to keep streets as wide and safe as possible. In areas where there are boulevards (grass strips between sidewalks and the street), that space is used for pushing and storage of snow. Those particular sidewalks, mostly in the older areas of the City, are being cleared without extensive cost.
