A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE AND TRANSFER OF SUDS AVENUE AND STANDARD STREET.

WHEREAS in accordance with Sections 8(1)(g) and 13(1)(b) of The Cities Act, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following streets be closed:

Firstly: All of Suds Avenue and Standard Street shown on Registered Plan No.

80Y12960, Yorkton, Saskatchewan; and,

Secondly: All of Suds Avenue shown on Registered Plan No. CI5775, Yorkton,

Saskatchewan

More specifically as shown in the shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A' which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

Effective Date of Bylaw

Consent to close these streets was given by the Minister of Highways and Infrastructure on May 18, 2010. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.
