BYLAW NO. 29/2009

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF ONE LANEWAY

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following laneway be closed:

"All that portion of the lane shown on Plan 99Y08572 lying directly between the Southerly limit of Lot 15, Block 18 and the Northerly limit of Lot 16, Block 18, Yorkton, Saskatchewan."

More specifically as shown in the shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A' which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

Effective Date of Bylaw

Consent to close these streets and laneways was given by the Minister of Highways on December 24, 2009. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.

Introduced and read a first time this 14th day of December, A.D., 2009.

Read a second time this 11th day of January, A.D., 2010.

Read a third time and adopted this 11th day of January, A.D., 2010.
