BYLAW NO. 33/87

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATIONS OF VIDEO ARCADES

The Council of the City of Yorkton enacts as follows:

- 1. An arcade shall be defined as a building or that part of a building, or that area of a building that contains any pinball machine or video game for the use of customers or the public.
- 2. An owner or operator of a games arcade shall not permit any person under sixteen (16) years of age to enter an arcade or play a games machine on a school day between (9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.) without the written consent of a parent or guardian having been obtained:
- 3. An arcade shall be assessed a business tax determined only by the area occupied by the business, with no additional license fee imposed:
- 4. An owner, operator, or person in charge of a video arcade who contravenes any provision of Section 2 shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable upon conviction to a penalty of not less than \$75.00 or more than \$500.00 and or costs.
- 5. That the License Fee for Pinball Arcades as outlined on Page 5 of Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of bylaw No. 2066 as amended by Bylaw No. 2139 be deleted.

Introduced and read a first time this 17th day of August, A.D. 1987.

Read a second time this 17th day of August, A.D. 1987.

Read a third time this 31st day of <u>August</u> A.D. 1987, after unanimous agreement had been reached to have a third reading, and then passed unanimously this 31st day of August, A.D., 1987, and registered in the Bylaw Register of the City of Yorkton.
