A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A ROAD

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1) g and 13 of *The Cities Act* of the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following street be closed:

1. Firstly: J.C. Beach Recreation Area - west of the Kinsmen Arena/Lions Ball Park, east of the Ducks Unlimited/Western Development Museum and south of the J.C. Beach Picnic Area - legally described as "NE ¼ - 3 - 26 - 4 - W of the 2nd", in the City of Yorkton, Saskatchewan."

More specifically as shown in the shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule "A" which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

2. Effective Date of Bylaw

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof.


