BYLAW NO. 7/99

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSING OF CERTAIN STREETS AND LANES, AS SUCH STREETS AND LANES ARE SHOWN ON A PLAN OF RECORD IN THE LAND TITLES OFFICE AS NOS. AF1841 AND W1884

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Yorkton deems it necessary that certain streets and lanes be closed to accommodate the development of Jubilee Park as a recreation area.

THEREFORE, in accordance with Section 156 of *The Urban Municipality Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following streets and lanes be closed:

FIRSTLY; "All of Fourth Avenue South, Third Avenue South, all that portion of Second Avenue South lying South of the South Easterly production of the South Westerly limit of Foster Street, all of Park Street, all that portion of the lane in Block 2, Yorkton, Plan AF1841; and

SECONDLY; All of Fourth Avenue, lane in Block 5 and all that portion of Cameron Street lying to the East of a line being the production Northerly of the West limit of Block 3 and West of a line joining the North East corner of Block 4 with the South East corner of Block 5, Yorkton, Plan W1884."
