BYLAW NO. 47/2008

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF ONE LANEWAY

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following laneway be closed:

"All that portion of the lane contained in Block 15, Plan No. 99Y07581, lying to the east of the easterly limit of McLeod Avenue and to the west of the westerly limit of Lawrence Avenue."

More specifically as shown in the shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A' which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

Effective Date of Bylaw

Consent to close this lane was given by the Minister of Highways on October 15, 2008. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.
