Bylaw No. 8/2021

**A Bylaw of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to provide for
the permanent closure of unused road allowance right-of-way adjacent to the
west of half of Section 9, Township 26, Range 4, West of the 2nd Meridian**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following street/road allowance be permanently closed:

1. As shown on Schedule 'A' attached hereto, all that portion of Road Allowance ORA 144-26-4-2 Ext. 144 being bound on the South by a straight line drawn between the intersection of the West boundary of the S.W. 1/4 Sec. 9 - Twp. 26 - Rge. 4 - W.2Mer. and the northern limit of Plan 42357, and the intersection of the East boundary of the S.E. 1/4 Sec. 8 - Twp. 26 - Rge. 4 - W.2Mer. and the northern limit of Plan 42357 and all that portion of Road Allowance ORA 146-26-4-2 Ext. 146.
2. That Bylaw No. 1/2021 be repealed.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
