A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO PROVIDE FOR THE SALE OF CERTAIN BUFFER STRIP

The Council of the City of Yorkton enacts as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to the Planning & Development Act, 1983, Section 187, a request has been made to the Minister of Urban Affairs to sell to the City the following Crown Lands:
 - (a) Buffer Strip BI Plan 82YO8682.
- 2. This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Urban Affairs.

Introduced and read a 1st time this 5th day of June A.D., 1989.
