Bylaw No. 17/2013

A Bylaw in the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to provide for the permanent closure of a portion of lane right-of-way south of 93 Sixth Avenue North.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following street be permanently closed:

“All that portion of lane right-of-way adjacently south of 93 Sixth Avenue South, legally described as Lot 11, Block 10, Plan P2307, as identified on Schedule ‘A’, attached to and forming part of this bylaw.”

Effective Date of Bylaw

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.

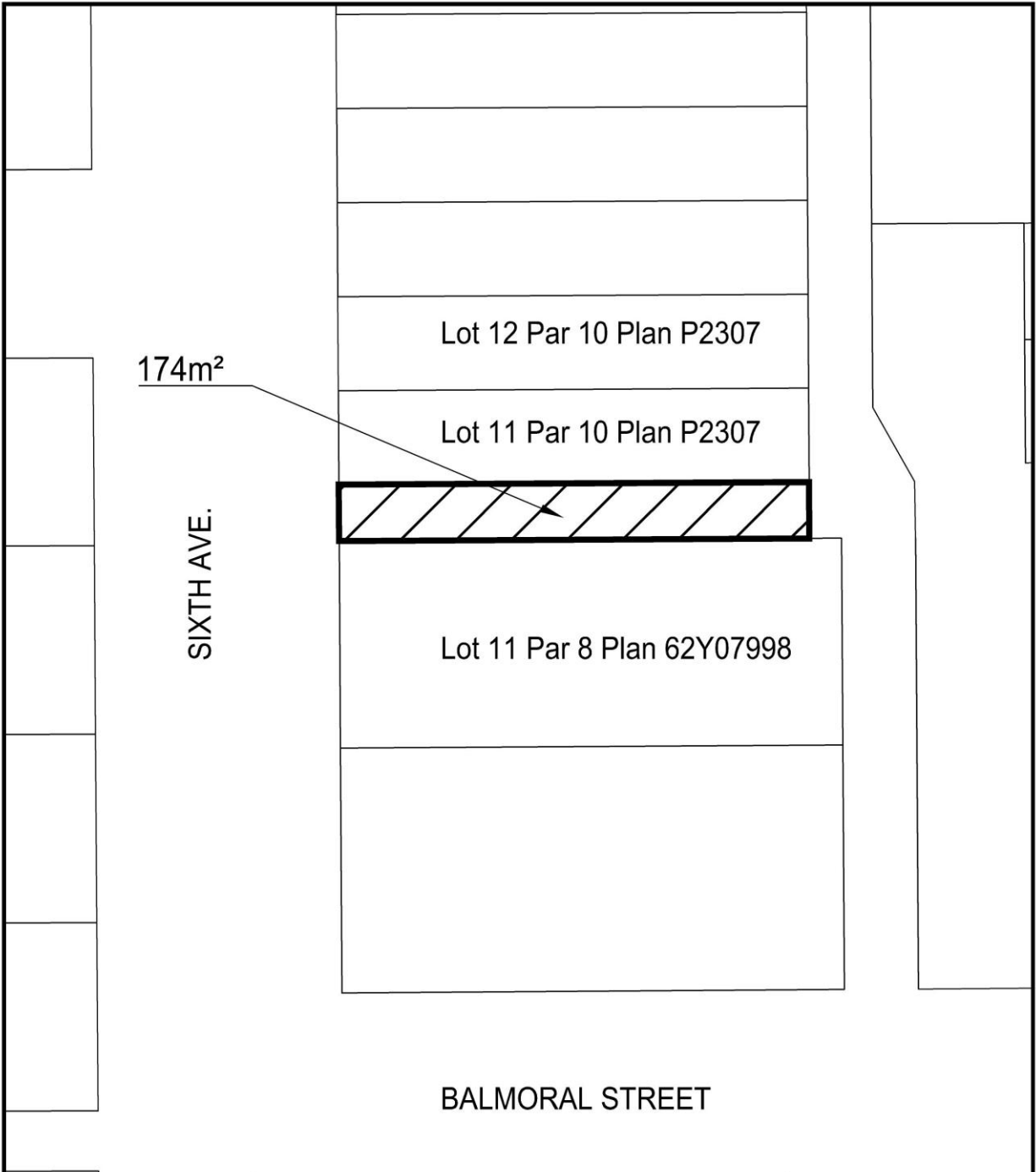
