



Glass bottles and jars are not accepted in the green community recycling bins or blue bags.

Glass may break in the bags and can be dangerous to staff who are sorting the materials.



They are accepted at the glass bin located at RecyclAbility Enterprises.



Help Our Collection Staff

- ✓ Sort bags as pictured above
- ✓ Remove plastic liners or windows from boxes/envelopes
- ✓ Rinse containers/tins
- Flatten cardboard/paperboard boxes
- Bags may be tinted (most common in blue), but must be transparent. Use the size that best suits your household needs.
- ✓ Bags must be tied

Room to Collect

Ensure there is at least 1 meter of space around your recycling bags and garbage to allow for safe efficient collection.





Please ensure carts are placed out the night before the scheduled collection day as collection times will vary. Also ensure empty carts are removed from the street the same day they have been emptied.

Residential Refuse Collection Statutory Holiday Schedule Changes

If your refuse collection day falls on a statutory holiday, the collection day will change. Visit yorkton.ca/waste for schedule changes.

Statutory holidays include Good Friday, Christmas Day, and New Years Day. The more we recycle and divert material from the landfill, the more sustainable the landfill will become which helps keep costs and levies to a minimum.



Green Sweep (Yorkton's curbside recycling program provided by Prairie Harvest Employment Program) creates employment opportunities for members of our community facing challenges. Bags make recycling collection and sorting possible without special machinery, which keeps costs low. There is no limit to the amount you can recycle at home. Put out as many bags as you want!






