A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSING OF A CERTAIN LANE AS SUCH LANE IS SHOWN ON A PLAN OF RECORD IN THE LAND TITLES OFFICE AS NO. Z2171

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 156 of *The Urban Municipality Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following street be closed:

"FIRSTLY: All that portion of the East-West lane, Block 21, Yorkton, Saskatchewan, Plan Z2171 lying West of a line being the production Southerly of the East limit of Lot 17, Block 21 on said Plan."
