A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN PROPERTY AS MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY

The Council of the City of Yorkton in accordance with the Heritage Property act enacts as follows:

1. That the property described as follows be designated as Municipal Heritage Property,

Legal - Lot 5, Block 1, Plan 9913 Yorkton, Saskatchewan (Minerals excepted)

Civic Description - 19 Broadway Street East, Yorkton, Saskatchewan.

Registered owner: Sampson Furniture Ltd.

- 2. The reasons for the designation are as follows:
 - a) Purchased in 1898 from a pioneer storekeeper to become the Hudson's Bay Company post in Yorkton.
 - b) Rebuilt in 1913 and modelled after Hudson's Bay Company structure of major cities in Canada.
 - c) The architectural design is unique to Yorkton and a focal point on Broadway Street.
 - d) It is one of two such buildings in Saskatchewan.
 - e) The European style terra-cotta sculpture is the major exterior decoration.
