A Bylaw in the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to provide for the permanent closure of a portion of Seventh Avenue North.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following street be permanently closed:

"All that portion of Seventh Avenue North commencing from the intersection with Broadway Street East to the southeast corner of Plan 00YO5677, Block 6, Lot 17, as identified on Schedule 'A', attached to and forming part of this bylaw."
